



Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru receives Environmental Clearance (EC) for second stage of expansion

Expansion to include the construction of a new passenger terminal along with the second runway

Bangalore, September 04, 2014

Bangalore International Airport Limited (BIAL) today announced that it has been formally accorded the EC for its second stage expansion of the Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru. This expansion will include the construction of a new terminal along with the second runway, taxiways, aprons, aircraft parking and all aviation facilities and structures. The expansion is envisaged to accommodate the future traffic growth which is likely to reach 55 million passengers annually by 2029-2030 and approximately 1 million tonnes of cargo movement. The expansion within the existing airport site area will cater to both aeronautical and non-aeronautical infrastructure facilities.

The second stage expansion approval was granted by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India. "The second stage EC for our airport is an exciting milestone which now paves the way for us to secure final approvals for the project. This expansion will help us in contributing significantly towards the state's economic development and is key to achieving our overall vision of making Bangalore the Gateway to South India. We remain committed to developing a world-class project in a timely and responsible manner and ultimately bring widespread benefits to this state"• said Mr. G V Sanjay Reddy, MD, BIAL.

The airport is recognized to have a considerable economic and social impact on the region. This impact extends to the wider benefit that the airport brings to the regional business interests. The proposed expansion will contribute not only to the economic development of the region but will also play a major role in propelling growth in the travel and tourism industry, which further has a cascading impact on allied industries. Besides the economic benefits, this expansion will create direct and indirect employment thereby contributing holistically to the economy of the state.

The existing terminal is a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) gold certified infrastructure by the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC). BIAL is also recognised by Airports Council International (ACI) and is accredited with Airport Carbon Accreditation Level 3 which is recognised as the optimisation level.
