GVK EMRI 108 service, Uttarakhand crossed a significant milestone as it served over 11 lakh emergencies in the state on 4 January, 2017. A get-together was organized in the office and the staff was congratulated for providing timely and effective services. The 108 service began operations on 15 May, 2008. With a fleet of 139 ambulances and 700 employees, around 400-450 calls are attended on a daily basis. Till date, a total of 4.26 lakh pregnant women have been transported to healthcare centres and around 9000 child births have been assisted in the ambulances. The 108 team has saved over 28,300 lives since inception.
